The Competition

The Growing Future Assets
Competition was launched in 2020
and year-on-year it has grown,
engaging more 13–18-year-old girls
across Scotland with the support of
their teachers and our Investment
Mentors.

The annual competition runs over 10 weeks (September – December). Teams of 3 – 6 girls:

- Are matched with a volunteer Investment Mentor
- Choose a company from our selection
- Research and analyse the company
- Produce a written Research Report and Elevator Pitch video outlining their investment case

Winners and runners-up in junior (13-15 years) and senior (15-18 years) categories win cash prizes for their school of up to £1,000, and vouchers for team members.

Special prizes are awarded for the best Elevator Pitch Video and ESG Case.

The number of schools registering for the contest is also up by 38%, with almost a fifth of all the country's state schools now engaged in the venture. But we can still do more and with your help, we can go further.





Future Asset FAQs

What is Future Asset?

Future Asset is a programme that informs teenage girls in Scotland about investment management, enthuses them about careers in the sector, and widens the talent pipeline whilst improving diversity in the industry. We advocate that being female should never be a barrier to pursuing any career whilst helping them to develop skills, confidence and purpose.

When did Future Asset launch?

Future Asset was established in 2016 by a group of professionals from Edinburgh based investment firms. It launched in September 2017 with a conference for over 400 girls from across Scotland.

How did the idea for Future Asset come about?

The idea stemmed from a lunch hosted in Spring 2016 to discuss Dame Jayne-Anne Gadhia's government- sponsored report Empowering Productivity: Harnessing the Talents of Women in Financial Services. Then CEO of Virgin Money, Dame Jayne-Anne challenged the group of investment managers present to promote greater gender diversity in our firms, so we decided we ought to do something about it.

Who runs Future Asset?

Future Asset is directed by a Steering Group of professionals from the investment management sector in Scotland under the auspices of the Didasko Education Company Limited, a regulated Scottish financial education charity. It is run by a small team with the invaluable support of volunteers from the industry.

Who is on the Future Asset Steering Group?

The Future Asset Steering Group is comprised of a group of primarily female professionals, who are actively engaged in the Scottish financial sector, working mainly in investment management. Drawn from several different firms, members are united in their determination to increase diversity in the sector. We are also advised by our Programme Development Group of educationalists and careers specialists.

How does Future Asset benefit girls across Scotland?

Future Asset runs a range of activities that engage, inform and educate girls about investment management and enable them to consider careers in the sector.

Our annual Growing Future Assets competition challenges teams of girls in Scottish schools to research, analyse and pitch a company for investment to a group of industry professionals. The competition aims to introduce girls to the world of investment as well as the range of careers available.

We also produce educational resources, run events for students and teachers, and support students to gain work related experience.

Do you ever plan to expand out of Scotland?

We don't plan to extend Future Asset outside Scotland, but we are keen to collaborate with others who have the same mission and work closely with a number of similar projects.

How is Future Asset funded?

Future Asset is a trading name of the Didasko Education Company Limited, a financial education charity registered in Scotland. Future Asset is funded by the generous support of investment management firms who are committed to increasing diversity in the industry and backed by a family charity.

Who are Didasko Education Company Limited?

Founded by Professor Russell Napier and supported by the generosity of a number of benefactors, Didasko Education Company Limited is a charity that believes in the power of education in driving change in the financial sector, among professionals and the wider public. They have a unique approach to financial education, with a focus on financial history, and a style that celebrates the joy of learning.


